



FACULTY BOARD MEMBER POSITION NEDA Education Foundation

Description of Position

Faculty position with full voting rights on Foundation Board The NEDA Education Foundation BOD meets semi-annually with meetings in September and March/April at designated locations. BOD members are also strongly encouraged to attend the NEDA Executive Conference in the fall. The Faculty Board position is a three-year appointment and will be approved by the NEDA BOD.

Requirements for the Position:

Faculty BOD member should be a full-time faculty member at a university with an Industrial Distribution degree program or similar degree program. The qualified nominee should be committed to research and academic endeavors intended to advance the discipline of industrial and/or electronic distribution. Responsibilities will begin in spring of 2010.

NEDA Expectations for Faculty BOD Member:

- Attend all NEDA Education Foundation BOD meetings. NEDA will make hotel arrangements and will reimburse reasonable travel expenses;
- Serve as Faculty Editor of the *Review of the Electronic and Industrial Distribution Industries*, NEDA's journal;
- Attend the NEDA Executive Conference and EDS as their respective university's Project Host sponsor;
- Co-facilitate the Faculty Networking Sessions at NEDA Project Host events, the NEDA Executive Conference and EDS;
- Submit academic articles for publication in the NEDA journal;
- Encourage library subscriptions of the NEDA journal at targeted NEDA Project Host universities;
- Solicit academic participation in the NEDA journal;
- Network with faculty at Project Host targeted universities and promote participation in NEDA activities.

The Selection Process:

NEDA encourages self-nomination for this position. Interested candidates should submit a fully-completed NEDA Foundation Faculty Board Nomination Form (attached) and a current Curriculum Vita. Nominee packets will be reviewed by the NEDA Board of Directors. The deadline for submission is September 1, 2009. The NEDA Selection Committee will review all qualified candidates and notify all candidates by October 1, 2009 of their decision. The newly appointed member will attend the spring 2010 Board of Directors' meeting.
